### **Wednesday**

Read: Mark 4:35-41, Matthew 14:22-36

Truth: The power of Jesus is supreme and ultimate.

Question: What did the power of Christ prevail over?

Reflect: Do you live your life confident in the power of Christ?

### **Thursday**

Read: Exodus 34: 29-35

Truth: Others can see the impact God has on our lives.

Question: What happened when Moses spoke directly with God?

Reflect: Is it obvious to others that God has changed your life?

### **Friday**

Read: Luke 2:8-20, 1 Peter 1:3

Truth: Worship is an outpouring of your heart to God.

Question: How did the shepherds react to the Messiah?

Reflect: Make a list of everything you want to praise God for.

### **Saturday**

Read: Hebrews 4:12, 2 Timothy 3:16-17

Truth: God's Word is holy and ultimate truth.

Question: What power does the Word of God have?

Reflect: Do you trust the Bible as the only source of truth?
